Introduction:

The WCRC organized CONTACT2020 competition as an inter-competition during the pandemic and is associated with the regular World CanSat/Rocketry Championship.

57 teams from all over the World applied to participate in the competition. Contestants submitted several gigabytes of fantastic material. On this occasion, we would like to thank everyone for their effort and perseverance, especially because this is the first time such a competition has been organized and even under such global conditions. Many teams had a problem with the procurement of equipment, but with their resourcefulness and expertise as well as mutual cooperation, they managed to achieve excellent results.

By your example, you have motivated and inspired us all a lot and set high standards!

The Official Competition Rules were:

Entry Categories:

- Weather Satellite images (NOAA/METEOR) (CAT I)
- CubeSat Telemetry (CAT II)

Entries had to Include (copied from original document):

1. Drawings with dimensions (hand drawings are not acceptable);
2. A list of materials required to build the Ground Station (Antenna, Receiver);
3. Photographs of the installed Ground Station and Antenna;
4. Collected data;
5. The entry category you've chosen for your design Your name, postal address, and e-mail address.
Only one entry per individual or team will be accepted

Judging:

All entries were reviewed by the Jury. The Winners are selected based on categories and performance as predicted by the Judges, as well as ingenuity of design, mechanical and electrical safety, and durability, as well as the number and quality of data collected.

Prize:

All Winners, individuals or teams, in each category have been published on the WCRC website (below) and, as the main Prize, will go directly to the World Finals of the regular World CanSat/Rocketry Championship without the need to participate in the National and Continental CanSat/Rocketry Competition!

The WCRC Jury decided not to announce the first three places separately but to announce 7 Winners in the same rank (so everyone wins first place)!
